Ages:

- Birth – 21 years

Types of well visit quality measures:

- HEDIS
- EPSDT (Well Child Check-up)
- Access to primary care practitioner

Triple-Aim CPT codes

Meet the specifications for all well visit types (HEDIS, EPSDT, and Access to Primary Care Providers).

Impacts the provider's performance score for all well visit quality metrics.
