Documentation Reminders

Face-to-face Visit

- Code and bill only for diagnoses that you have treated and documented on today's Date of Service (DOS). Document and bill all diagnoses that:
 - Currently affect patient care; and/or
 - Necessitate treatment.
- Diagnoses billed on a claim must match what was documented in the EMR.

Use Appropriate Verbiage

- Be sure there is documentation that each condition has been **Monitored, Evaluated, Assessed, or Treated (MEAT)** in the medical record. This demonstrates the effect on patient care and/or treatment noted above.
- Below are examples of how to use appropriate verbiage in the HPI and the Assessment and Plan (A&P)
 - Example in the HPI:
 - Patient presents with a chief complaint of AAA, and for evaluation of and assessment for potential complications of chronic condition(s) including XXX, YYY, ZZZ
 - Example in the A&P:
 - Chronic condition XXX is stable and will continue current management
 - Chronic condition YYY's management requires the following interventions/changes.
 - Chronic condition ZZZ is stable and is currently being managed by a specialist

Monitor and Report

- For diagnoses that do not go away, monitor and report as least once per year, e.g.:
 - Permanent Ostomies: Z93.0 - Z93.9
 - Transplant Status: Z94.1 - Z94.84

Oncology

- If the disease is being actively treated, code an active cancer. Treatment examples include:
 - Chemotherapy
 - Radiation Therapy
 - Surgery
 - Palliative
 - Antineoplastic medications following surgery or other treatment
- **"Left upper lobe lung cancer, currently undergoing chemotherapy."**
- **"Right female breast cancer s/p mastectomy, continuing on Tamoxifen."**
- Document a "history of" cancer and utilize a personal-history "Z code" if the disease is no longer being actively treated; e.g. **Z85.05 Personal history of malignant neoplasm of liver.**
- Specify ALL primary and secondary metastatic sites.

Definitive Diagnoses

- Diagnoses must be definitive before billing/coding. Avoid using language like "consistent with," "probable," or "history of" (unless the condition is resolved and is now "history").
- If the condition is still active, use more descriptive language, such as:
 - "Controlled Type II DM," rather than "History of Type II DM"
 - "Compensated CHF," rather than "History of CHF"
- If no definitive diagnosis has yet been made, document and code the patient's symptoms.

Alcoholism / Drug Abuse and Dependence

- For alcohol abuse and dependence, specify if the patient is currently intoxicated, in withdrawal, or in remission.
