

Follow Up After ED Visit for Mental Illness

Measure Description

Percentage of ED visits for patients 6 years of age and older with a principal diagnosis of mental illness or intentional self-harm who had a follow-up visit for mental illness within 7 days of the ED visit

Documentation Requirements

Administrative Only - Claim for a follow-up visit with any practitioner, with a principal diagnosis of mental health disorder or intentional self-harm and any diagnosis of mental health disorder and follow-up received within 7 days of the ED Visit

NOTE: If patients had more than one ED visit in a 31-day period, include only the first eligible ED visit

Coding Requirements

Coding (must include a principal diagnosis of a mental health disorder or with a principal diagnosis of intentional self-harm and any diagnosis of a mental health disorder)

NOTE: Telehealth visits with modifier 95 or GT also count

Exclusions

Exclude ED visits that result in an inpatient stay and ED visits followed by admission to an acute or nonacute inpatient care setting on the date of the ED visit or within the 30 days after the ED visits, regardless of principal dx of the admission.
