

Dear Provider:

Lighthouse Health Plan covers all medical, mental health and substance abuse services for both children and adults as described in the Florida Medicaid handbooks. Covered behavioral health benefits include inpatient services, physician services, assessment/evaluation services, treatment planning, individual and family therapy services, case management services, day treatment services, and psychosocial rehabilitation, plus many more. (Select benefit limitations outlined below.) For children, Lighthouse Health Plan offers additional specialized therapeutic services including Foster Care, Therapeutic Group Care, and Comprehensive Assessments. There are no co-payments and, for most services, no authorization is required when you go to an in-network provider.

Per Medicaid policy, there is no limitation on medically necessary services for children. As outlined below, the behavioral health and substance use treatment benefits for adults enrolled in Lighthouse Health Plan provide ample coverage, including but not limited to:

- Inpatient hospital days - 45 days per year for adults (unlimited if emergent)
- Visits with a psychiatrist for medications - unlimited
- Medication Assisted Treatment - up to 52 visits per year
- Assessment/Evaluation - up to 2 assessments per year by a psychiatrist, and 1 assessment per year by a therapist
- Treatment Planning - up to 3 sessions per year
- Individual and Family Therapy - up to 26 one hour sessions per year (or 1 visit every 2 weeks)
- Case Management Services - up to 1032 hours per year
- Day Treatment - about 12 half days per year
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation - up to 480 hours per year
